Sandy Williams will review the book "**The Changing Face of Islam in America:**" Understanding and Reaching Your Muslim Neighbor. This book shares a street level view of the agenda and teachings of American Muslims, evaluates the Islamic faith and practices from the perspective of evangelical Christianity, and motivates believers to become more involved in enriching personal encounters with Muslims neighbors.
